Tender Security: A Tender Bond issued by a registered bank or insurance company in the amount of \$860,000 or a Manager's Cheque in the sum of \$430,000 made payable to the "Chief Executive Officer - National Works Agency".

Return of Tenders: Completed tenders along with the required documents: National Contract Commission (NCC) Certificate of Registration and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC), etc. are to be placed in an envelope labelled "DUNBARS TO SMITHFIELD BRIDGE, WESTMORELAND". The envelope should then be placed in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in the reception area of the National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10.
